Citrus-crazed February & March give way to earthier green of April & May, and of course, morels.

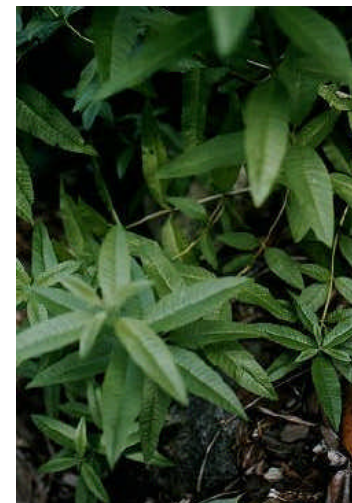
